

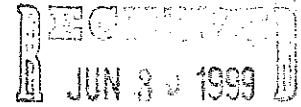

**Re: Acu Evac II**

Dear Mr. Yeh:

For the last six months the faculty of the Department of Dermatology at Harvard Medical School and the Cosmetic Surgery and Laser Center have been using the Acu Evac II for a variety of surgical procedures including laser skin resurfacing with both the CO<sub>2</sub> and Erbium Yag Lasers. As you well know, suction devices for procedures that generate significant amounts of plume, such as Erbium and CO<sub>2</sub>, laser resurfacing has been inadequate. Your development of the Acu Evac II has made a dramatic change in our ability to perform these procedures. The Acu Evac II has a patented unique nozzle (Tx) and suction which evacuates large amounts of plume in a relatively quiet, relatively low flow state, and highly effectively. This is in contradistinction to the traditional evacuation systems that we have used which generate high turbulent flow but leave behind an awful lot of plume in the air.

Plume generated from surgical procedures is hazardous, both to patients and to the medical personnel in the surgical suite and it is for that reason that we are delighted that you have developed this new device.


The devices work effortlessly with no service needs over the six months and as you have developed the newest nozzle tips device has worked even more efficiently.

This is our suction device of choice in the Cosmetic Surgery and Laser Center for all procedures that generate plume including laser hair removal, laser resurfacing, and especially electrodesiccation.
